In addition to medications which are required to be covered at a \$0 copay by the Affordable Care Act, Amwins Rx offers a list of selected medications at a \$0 copay for many chronic conditions. This program improves adherence to prescribed drug therapy by removing financial barriers to care, resulting in improved chronic disease state outcomes. Member satisfaction may also increase with this program as members will experience lower out-of-pocket costs for many common medications.

How does it work?

Plans who opt in to the Amwins Rx Zero Copay Maintenance Medication Program agree to absorb the cost of the member copay. Most of the medications listed are generic drugs. Although the plan will experience a slight increase in medication cost, overall healthcare costs are expected to decrease due to the costs avoided under the medical plan.
